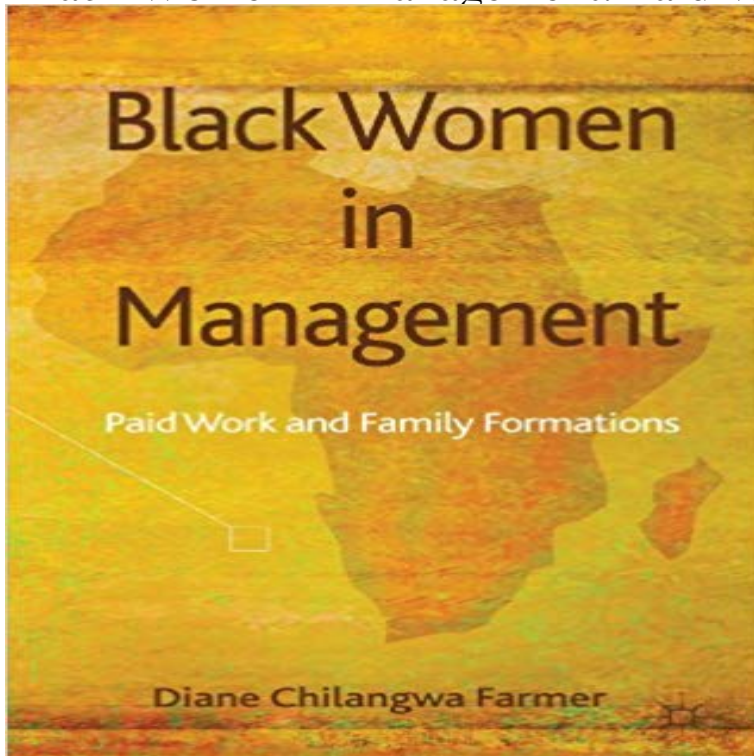


# Black Women in Management: Paid Work and Family Formations
