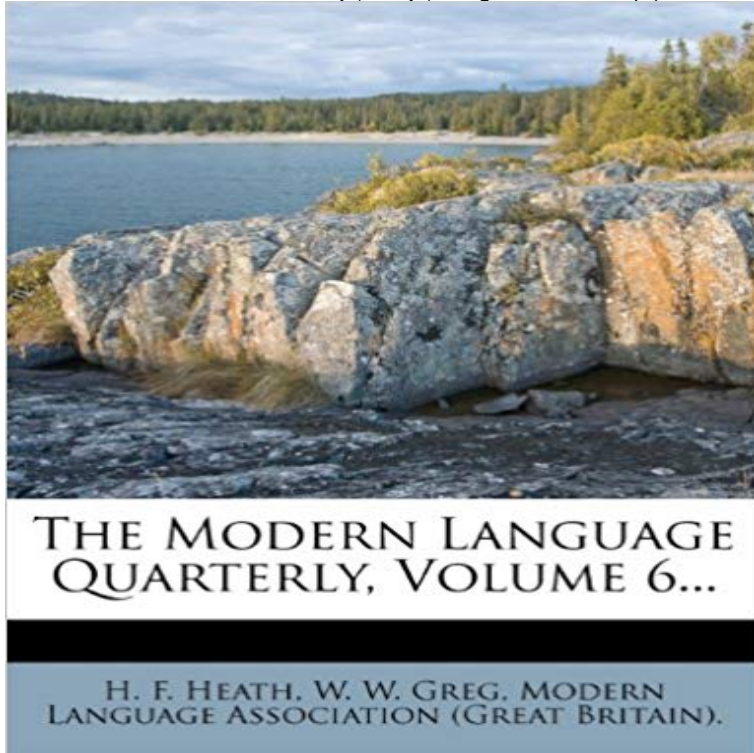


## The Modern Language Quarterly, Volume 6...
