Lush pinks, lime greens, succulent yellows and bright reds splash the Minimalistic walls of Centre del Carme. In a radical leap from canvas to mural Craig-Martin has brought a new sense of colour and graphic to a familiar interior. Crazy and beautiful tones are his bold and very personal interpretation of a Zurbaran still-life and Velazquez's Las Meninas. The immaculate accompanying catalogue more than adequately conveys the vitality of this work. Full page spreads of the space with essays by Teresa Millet and Enrique Juncosa are printed with a gloss lamination and lustre in mind.
