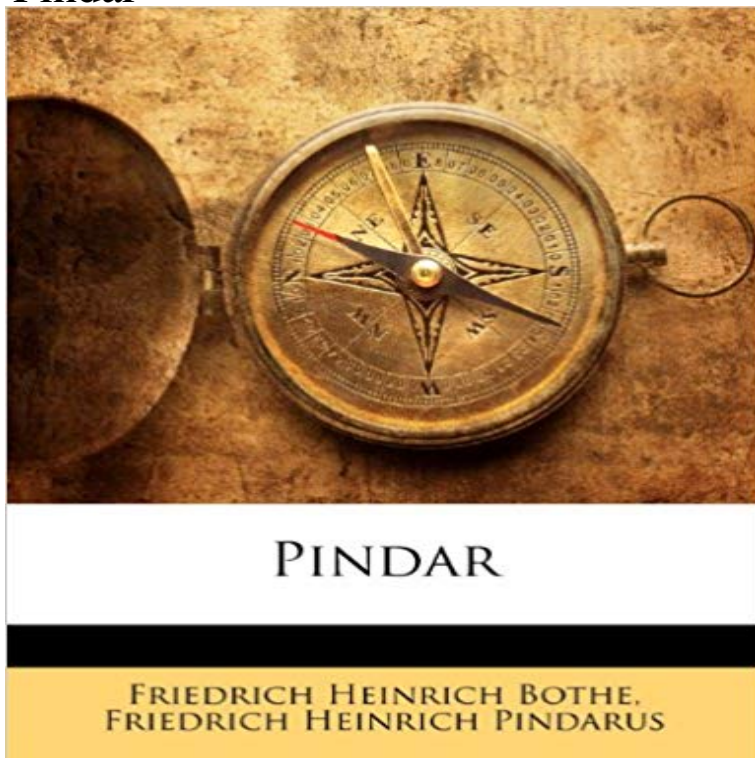


# Pindar
