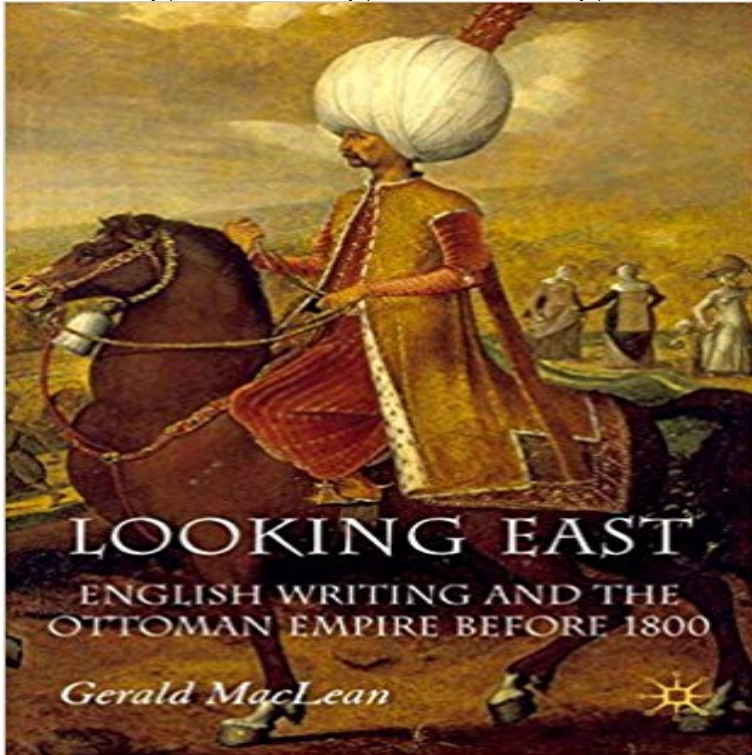


Looking East: English Writing and the Ottoman Empire Before 1800
