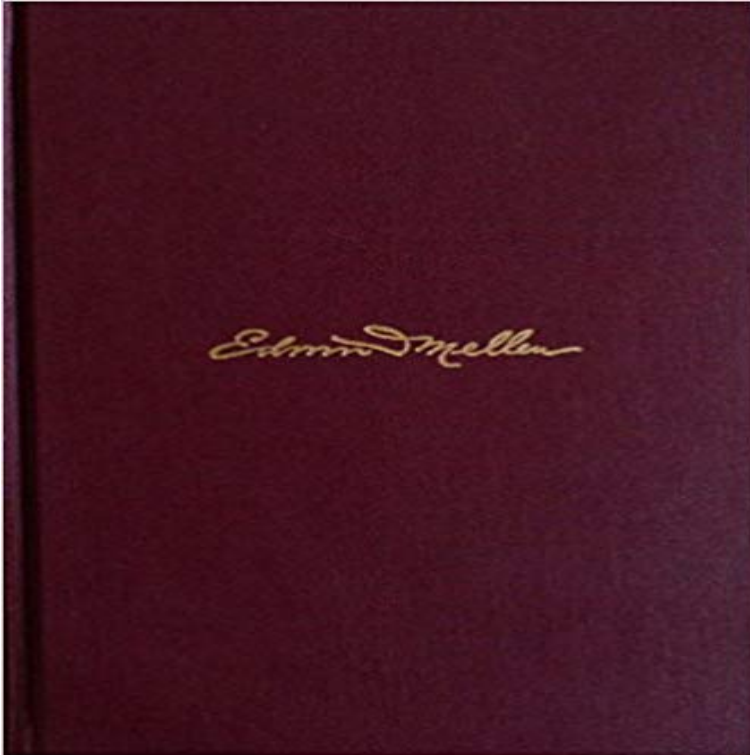


# Ethical Dilemmas in Modern Medicine: A Physicians Viewpoint (Studies in Health & Human Services)
